We reserve the right to combine and/or cancel any or all classes. Ponies shown in Pony Classes may cross enter into Horse classes, but may not win Horse High Point with the same rider. Pony may be shown in horse class with a different rider and still qualify for high point awards. **NO TRAINING AIDES** in performance classes. Snaffle bits allowed for horses 5 years and younger. No gag bits or hackamore bits allowed in performance classes (See OHA rules for list of legal bits). Riders must be 17 years and under as of 10/1/098. Ponies must be 58" inches and under, with ½ inch allowed for shoes. Boots required. Hat or helmet required in all performance classes. **Chaps are optional.** Western attire required in both Performance and Gaming classes.
